

Visiting Assistant Professor of Education - 3 year

The Department of Education at The College of Wooster invites applications for a visiting assistant professor specializing in Adolescent to Young Adult (AYA) pedagogy (grades 7-12), experiential learning, and foundations of education (i.e. global education, urban education, cultural competency). Responsibilities include teaching a range of content and methodology courses, supervising field and student teaching, and academic advising. Position entails teaching courses such as AYA Introductory and Advanced Methodology and Curriculum Studies courses along with a specialized electives such as Urban Education, Global Education, Content Area Literacy, and Student Teaching Seminar. Knowledge of and active contribution to the department's accreditation and assessment process is also expected. The College of Wooster enrolls a diverse student body (21% domestic students of color and 15% international students). Three years of teaching experience in grades 7-12 is required. Teaching licensure/certification in 7-12 social studies, mathematics, or language arts is preferred. Ph.D. or Ed.D. required.

Applicants should submit the following documents through Interfolio by December 31, 2018: cover letter, curriculum vitae, statement of teaching philosophy, evidence of strong teaching (syllabi and student evaluations, if applicable), diversity statement, research statement, scholarly writing sample, graduate transcripts (unofficial), and three letters of recommendation. The diversity statement should speak to the candidate's ability to engage with issues of diversity in the classroom and the curriculum, as well as on campus and in the broader community. Interfolio accounts are free to applicants – simply press “apply.” All applications received by the deadline will receive full consideration.
